FELLOWSHIP TOGETHER

- 1. How has the last week been? Go around the room and ask, "How are the Smith's?"
- 2. Is there anything from our last meeting that you've seen working in real life?

GROW IN MATURITY TOGETHER

Read together from Matthew 25:14-30. Then watch the video.

PRINCIPLES OF STEWARDSHIP...

- 1. Everyone is a <u>steward</u> no exceptions.
- 2. Being faithful with <u>little things</u> is the pathway to being entrusted with <u>more influence</u>.
- 3. God wants me to invest in His kingdom in a way that requires risk and faith.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION...

- What difference does it make when I see *everything* as belonging to God and myself merely as the *manager* of it?
- We need to hunger for more influence and more to manage, but we need to be faithful in the little things first. In what ways would you like to have more to manage?
- How do you struggle to manage what you've already been entrusted with?
