Ephesians 1:19b-21

That power is the same as the mighty strength he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.

- >> The power of God operating in your life is the difference between salvation for heaven and salvation for life.
- >> So many of us don't feel like the power of God is in us because we don't really understand it.

Comes from the Father, because Jesus, in the power of the Holy Spirit

- >> The Holy Spirit is the presence of God that lives inside of you.
- >> Some of us don't know the power of God inside of us because we have distanced ourselves from the Holy Spirit because we have seen the Holy Spirit blamed for a lot of weird things.
- >> A lot of us don't feel the power of God in us because we have been disappointed by the Holy Spirit.
